

# The President's Corner



Dear Members,

Today, I wish to use my article, not only to discuss some of our upcoming events, but also to raise the issue of a Special Meeting, that is being planned, with regard to the Germania Club's property at Lake Dalrymple.

We are pleased to report, that the Friday night dances have been very successful, with a bi-weekly attendance of at least 80 persons. The Germania Club's Easter Egg Hunt and the Maifest of the Fishers and Hunters were enjoyed by many families. We encourage all of you, to continue to support these events that are planned and executed by a small group of dedicated volunteers. We are also forging full steam ahead with preparations for, "It's Your Festival", that will take place in Gage Park from July 9-12th. The dates for the event are one week later than in other years, to coincide with the Pan Am Games. The Club's annual picnic at Germania Park on Aug. 9th is not that far away, as well. So if you are looking for a volunteer

opportunity, here it is. I guarantee, no offers for help will be turned down. Don't forget that in June, the Germania Club will show the soccer games for the Women's World Cup soccer championship, whenever the German team competes.

As you may know, we rent the Germania Club parking lot, from time to time to movie studios, for film shoots. This June, scenes from the movie adaptation from a Stephen King novel, about the Kennedys, will be shot for the first time, inside the Club, in the Banquet Hall. On May, 4th, 2015, at 7:30 pm, the Board of Directors invited the Executive of the Fishers and Hunters, for a joint meeting on the topic. There were two items on the agenda: one was cost-sharing of property taxes and insurance, for the use of Germania Park by the Fishers and Hunters; the other was a notification, that the Board of Directors is arranging another Special Meeting, in accordance with our bylaws, to bring the Lake Dalrymple property issue to an end, once and for all. Unfortunately, the revival of this matter was met with great consternation and indignation. The Fishers and Hunters feel strongly, that the Board is demonstrating a bias, in favour

of those members, wishing to sell the property. Let me be very clear on this point. Your Germania Club Board represents the entire Club membership. The outcome of the issue will be determined by a membership vote, not by the Board. So when the time comes, be prepared to stand up and be counted. The Special Meeting provides the opportunity for all those wishing to state their case, to be heard. We are hoping for a Special Meeting date in September. Over the coming months, we will provide you with details by letter and in the Germania Post.

All of us are members, because we wish to promote and preserve our German culture and its customs and values. We hope that all of you embrace those basic principles.

Please enjoy your summer, and all that your Germania Club has to offer.
