The President's Corner



Dear Members,
We could not have picked a better summer day for celebrating our annual Germania Club Picnic at our park. Once again the park is in great shape. The Campers set up everything, including the fence. They also ensured that as many shady seats as possible were available. This was very much appreciated by about 125 members and non-members, who came out to enjoy the great afternoon with family and friends. I believe that our junior guests were also well looked after. The pony rides are always a big hit with the little ones. It was nice to see that all the kids took part in all the games that were set up for them. It turned out to be quite a competition, and winners were rewarded with a ribbon and a prize and other goodies. We were desperately trying to get the parents and grandpar-

ents involved in the games, without great success. I am sure that the heat had something to do with the lack of interest.

As every year, there is a variety of good food, cold beer, drinks and coffee and cake for everyone to enjoy at the Picnic. However, this year there was something missing, something we have enjoyed and appreciated year after year. It was the delicious home-baked cakes and pastries provided and donated by the Germania Club's Ladies' Auxiliary, and by other Club volunteers. It was certainly noticed, and had a big effect on our coffee and cake sales.

Just for clarification, I would like to provide the following information. Every year we are obligated to apply for a special event permit from the L.C.B.O. When you apply for this permit, other departments could become involved. These departments include the following of the City of Hamilton: the City Fire Department, the City Building Department, and the City Health Department. This year we had, for the first



time, a visit by the health inspector at the Park, prior to our Picnic. Because I had no knowledge of the time of the inspection, I arranged a meeting with the inspector to discuss the concerns. We reviewed all the basic food handling; hand washing; and dishwashing procedures; basically the same as those requiring our compliance at “It’s Your Festival” at Gage Park and Octoberfest.

Two issues had to be addressed in detail: the campers volunteered to provide and make the potato salad for the Picnic in the pavilion kitchen. The only way that could happen is, if we provided everything needed, to raise the kitchen to compliance levels with all food handling regulations. The second concern is the following: our Picnic is a special event, and the public is invited. This is the key point: the public has access. The rules state: “No home prepared, or home-canned foods can be used, sold or given away at special events”. It is very important to point out, that if you are planning a private function

at any of our facilities, please continue to do so. You may or may not require a “private special event” permit. The regulations are different for each situation.

At the end of the day, I believe everyone had a good time. I like to thank everyone for coming and making this another successful function. It takes a lot of time, work and planning by many volunteers. On behalf of the Board of Directors I would like to thank everyone for their time and efforts to make this possible. A special thank you goes out to the campers for making the potato salad and preparing the Park for this function.
