We were running somewhat late in starting the second half of the program, mainly because people lingered over dinner, chatted, drank an extra glass of this or that. However, there were no complaints that I am aware of, and eventually the festivities continued. There followed introductions of the new Board, special guests, and the awarding of membership certificates. Werner Grote and Horst Kaufeld celebrated this year their 50th membership anniversary. Werner's biography was read by Club Secretary Jeanet Schaefer. Unfortunately Horst was unable to attend. We wish both of them the very best.
