In 2003, after big fundraising efforts by club members, a contractor repaired the same roof, at a cost of \$21,000. He installed what is called an upside down roof, right over 2 other roof layers. The heavy gravel is meant to hold



down the layer of Styrofoam. Because of all the trees growing on the roof, I refer to it as the Black Forest.



The only way to resolve this nightmare is to start from the beginning. All of the roof material has to be removed, and disposed of, right to the base. 
