However, at the same time, this is a friendly reminder that there is really no vacation time at the Germania Club, so I hope that not everyone travels too far away and keeps the Club in mind. are hoping to install at least one new AC unit. A total cost estimate is not complete, since we are receiving cost estimates from more than one company. The work has to be done. The work has to be done right, and it has to be done now, before we have to stop using the hall. Not only will the project be costly, but it will also require a lot of time, before this work is completed.

I could write about many other things, but for now I would like to acknowledge the volunteers for their time and effort to help out, whenever needed. It is really very much appreciated. It is time to give a big thank you to the group of volunteers, providing us with the Sunday lunch and movie afternoons. They help out, month after month, including

donating cakes and other food items, and they are willing to step in on short notice. The Leserkreis Germania is another group of volunteers, whom I like to thank very They have much. now celebrated their first year and continue to gain momentum due to a lot of hard work, efforts and donations from Club members. On behalf of the Board of Directors, I would also like to thank Club members for continuously attending and supporting all our functions, and we hope that others will join us. Thank you very much.




