62 years ago, 4 members of the Germania Club came together and formed the Mardi Gras group. Narrhalla '58. It was brought to life to bring a little bit of what those members had at home in Germany to their new country Canada. The Narrhalla ran successfully from 1958 to 2013, at which point it went into a deep sleep. The Narrhalla was a spark that started many Mardi Gras groups in Ontario, earning Hamilton the title of "Mardi

Gras Capitol of Canada" signed by all levels of government.

I think it is time that we bring the Narrhalla out of its deep sleep, like the waking of the jester "Hoppeditz" at the beginning of the Mardi Gras season. Mardi Gras or Karneval, Fasching, Fasnacht or Fasnet as it's called in Germany brings joy and fun to many millions of people of all ages in Germany, and to thousands in Canada over the years.

My plan is to form a committee to plan a few events for the Karneval season 2019 starting with possibly a Hat Night or Kappenabend, a costume dance and to bring back the children's Mardi Gras. These three events were popular in the later years of the Narrhalla, and I see that as a starting point. Visiting other German Mardi Gras clubs as we did in years past is no longer possible, other than Narrenzunft Kitchener. I'm wondering if other clubs are thinking of waking their jester from a deep sleep too? Who knows?

I'm hoping that former members, and lovers of Karneval will join me. As my health steadily improves I see this as something I owe to the past, to those who came before us and built something really nice and loved.
