

An iron will and consistent rehabilitation exercises have done miracles for her, and we, along with her choir, are most thankful for her recovery.

It was good to see first-time attendees Brigitte Muessner and Christine Eastwood on screen for our virtual Germania Choir session in May. Nina and George Fischer, although the timing was not ideal, again joined us from Belleville for a little while, as did Christl Reglin-Petts from her retirement home in Oakville.

Our song on YouTube was "Die Gedanken sind frei", but I would suggest "Alte Kameraden" for our next session in June. And if we all get fully vaccinated, perhaps Hedda will stage that choir picnic at our beautiful Germania Park in September!!! By that time, we should be able to sing a "Ständchen" for Brigitte Muessner and Heinz Mildenberger, whose birthdays are on July 1st, Eva Kolwes, July 9th, Lore Schaefer, July 28th, and Gertrud Press, on July 30th.

I recently called an old engineering buddy of mine and asked what he was working on these days. He replied that he was working on "Aqua - ther-


mal treatment of ceramics, aluminum, and steel under a constrained environment."


