- Some members have the mistaken belief that present directors (and the President) can be compelled to serve another term if nobody else is willing to accept such a position. The general principle holds: a volunteer cannot be compelled to do anything except that which he/she volunteers for
- A nice lunch (roast beef/ red cabbage) will be available for \$10.

As we approach the day of the Annual General Members' Meeting, remember that the Board members are elected to serve the Club. Being able to get along and work with others is very important, and so is the ability to follow correct procedure. 



Alex Wegner

Alex Wegner was born June 6, 1926 in the town of Dahmken in West Preussen. At the age of 14 he began a three year apprenticeship and trade school program as an engine mechanic and diesel technician. At 17, he joined the Armed Forces heavy anti Aircraft, was captured on September 9, 1944 and became a Prisoner of War in Belgium. He was then shipped to Dieppe, France. In December 1944, he was transferred to a P.O.W. camp in England until 1948 when he was finally discharged. Back home, he worked on maintenance of the cars and trucks in a glass wholesale company until 1952

During 1952, Alex immigrated to Canada with his mother and after establishing himself as a qualified mechanic at Stelco. He married the love of his life Erika, on October 25, 1952. In 1958 he successfully obtained his Ontario Diesel Mechanics license. While

at Stelco, he established a very successful career as a qualified Diesel Mechanic. He received many accolades of achievement for outstanding work. In 1988, when Alex retired, his supervisor wrote the following "Alex has always been a highly respected technician in his line of work because of his extremely efficient use of working hours. He has set high standards of perfection and has been a model and inspiration to his fellow workers. Alex leaves behind a long list of excellent achievements, which will benefit all of us for many years to come. He has reasons to look back at those accomplishments with justifiable pride and a lot of satisfaction. It has been a real joy to work with him all these years."

In 1988, and after 36 years at Stelco, Alex retired and actively began building his cottage at Pickerel Lake, Burks Falls with his sons, Robert, Alfred and daughter Linda, so that he could spend enjoyable moments with all his children and their families. He is the proud Opa of six grandchildren.

Alex became a Member of the Germania Club on May 24, 1957. He has been a very active member of the Club and also the Fisher and Hunters. On March 11, 1979 Alex was elected as a Member of the Board of Directors of the Germania Club and became Property Manager. He is responsible for the daily maintenance of
