





Letter to the Editor:

Being a long standing member of the Germania Club and as well as several sub-groups, something has been brought to my attention that made my heart sink. I was recently informed that some of our members or possibly their guest's are breaking some very serious laws that are laid out by the Canadian Government. I had been recently questioned as to the fishing laws, not only at the Fisher and Hunters cottage, but as well as the lake where the Germania Park is located.

The rules as stated by the Ministry of Natural Resources under the "Fish and Wildlife Act" clearly state (for summer fishing) 1 person fishing, 1 fishing line. Also a valid fishing license is required. This applies to all residents of Ontario between the ages of 18 to 65. These rules are in place to prevent over-fishing and ensure a future for the young fisher people. The fines that may be handed out can be up to \$1,000,000 or 3 years imprisonment or confiscation of your equipment. Is this worth an extra fish? As an avid fisherman I have tried to instil the love of this sport to all, however when I was informed that a member was witnessed breaking this law, I was appalled.

More information is available at the Ministry website or any bait and tackle shop.
