JOE PARZEN, was born on February 11, 1932 in Bacsalmas, a little town in Hungary, the son of Margarete and Paul Parzen. His father was killed during the Second World War.

At the end of the war, he and his family had to leave Hungary and eventually found a new home in Dorndorf, a little village near the city of Ulm in southern Germany. It was there that Joe served an apprenticeship as an electrician.

In 1952, following his sister, Mar-

zella, who had left Germany earlier, he immigrated to Canada, settling in Hamilton. In 1954 he joined the Germania Club in order to play soccer.

To say that Joe had a significant involvement in Germania Club activities would be an understatement. During the past 70 years he was engaged in the following Club activities and functions:

Chairman, Theatre Group

Chairman, Fishing and Hunting Group

Chairman, Entertainment Committee

Chairman, Restaurant Committee Founding member of G.K.G. Narrhalla "58" (seeing it was under the umbrella of the Theatre Group at that time)

Member, Council of Elders



Member, Audit Committee Property Manager Germania Park Manager Treasurer, Soccer Group Member, Campers Group

In addition, he helped out as a waiter and organizer during all of the Club's social events; first at the Fischer Hotel and later, after the Club's large hall was built, at the King Street East location. He also played a major role in convincing the Club's Board of Directors and membership to purchase a beautiful building lot on the shore of Lake Dalrymple in 1959. Once the lot was acquired, he made a significant contribution to the construction of a large and welcoming cottage. When, a few years ago the cottage was sold, the Germania Club benefitted greatly from this sale.

As one of the first post-world war members, Joe was able to observe how relatively quickly the Club membership grew from fewer than 50 people to close to 1000!

He was also supportive of the Club's physical expansion activities, starting with the large hall, followed by the upstairs hall and meeting rooms, the aforementioned Lake Dalrymple property and - in 1960 - the acquisition of the beautiful Germania Park.

It may be hard to believe, but Joe did have a life outside the bounds of the Germania Club!

Once in Canada, he found employment as an electrician working on construction sites, both here and in the U.S.A.

He worked in his trade until he retired It was at the Germania Club, where he met and courted his future wife, Brigitte Boehner. Joe and Brigitte have three children; Ellen, Paul and Christopher. They also have six grandchildren; Chris, Sara, Rochelle, Jake, Neil and D.J.

Despite his busy working-, Cluband family life, Joe found time to cater to his hobbies of fishing, hunting, cottaging, camping and snowbirding in Florida.

He now lives in the western outskirts of Hamilton and enjoys watching T.V., discussing Germania Club politics and activities -- past, present and future!

If one had to pick one word which describes JOE PARZEN, it would be "L O Y A L T Y"!

Joe has always been loyal to his family, his friends, his relatives, his trade and to the GERMANIA CLUB.
