Like all members of the Germania Club, our choir is suffering from COVID Fatigue: We miss our weekly choir practices; we miss the camaraderie; we miss the socializing after a draining rehearsal! With the Christmas season approaching, our hearts ache to sing the old familiar advent songs, the ones we used to sing after supper, sitting at the kitchen table around the advent wreath, with Mama giving us a sample of the "Plätzchen" that she had been baking and storing for Christmas. There would be the "Lasst uns froh und munter sein, until "Nikolausabend", December 5th, when we would bring out our biggest pair of shoes - I cheated, I actually gave my father's boots a good shine before I put them outside our apartment door to the stairwell. No matter how poor our families were during that war and post-war time, it is the music, and perhaps some marzipan, some Lebkuchen, a couple of Zimtsterne, and an orange that made the season special.

With the exception of Cindy Heuck, all of our choir members were born during and toward the end of the War. Most of us did not get lavish presents from Christkind, but we have cherished memories of a pre-Christmas season filled with mystery and longings, followed by a Christmas Eve that was special, indeed. And we would sing! No matter how poor our families were during that war and post-war period, it was the music, perhaps some Lebkuchen, a couple of Zimtsterne, and an orange, along with a new nightgown or teddy bear that made the season special.

It is strange, how most of us become very nostalgic about our post-war childhood memories of Christmas. At rehearsals, some of us can be seen wiping away a tear or two, as we practise some of the old carols that bring back memories of times gone by. Even though our children, and even more so our grandchildren, have received bigger and more expensive presents, and even though they can eat cookies, oranges, and marzipan all year round, I do not envy them. The present-day commercialism with its blaring loudspeakers and lavish gift-giving are a poor substitute for what present-day Scandinavians call hygge, the simple pleasures of life. And singing and spending time together is most definitely one of them.
