Jeanet Schaefer, our "Notenwart", with a bit of help from other choir members, is currently using the extended break in rehearsals to re-organize our music, which over the years has taken up the space of several filing cabinets behind the stage, as well as a number of cupboards upstairs, in the area where the choir used to have practices. It is a formidable task, to say the least, since our repertoire spans over 160 years, back to the days when there was a male choir only.

Although the current pandemic prevented us from giving our traditional Christmas concerts, the choir has tried to keep up the tradition of supporting the Outreach Program at First Pilgrim United Church by donating non-perishable food items and clothing for families in need.
