I was speaking with Club president Garry Bulmer about the new Covid-19 restrictions for the Germania Park and Campground and was asked to put in a note to Campers.

The Camper's meeting, that was to be on May 8 in the Fisher & Hunter Hall in the Germania Park, is cancelled due to Provincial restrictions. Possibly a Zoom virtual meeting will be set-up as a replacement. Details to follow.

The Park will open on May 1st, the water and hydro will be on.

At this time, only members are to be in the Park, and Campers are to keep to their sites. No guests are allowed at this time. No overnight camping is permitted.

The washrooms are locked and will not be available. You will need to use your washrooms in your trailer. All wastewater is to be dumped at the wastewater tank out back of the Pavilion, this includes greywater

(wash water).

Further to this the Conservation authority has placed a "Catch and release restriction" on the lake in order to replenish fish stocks. The Conservation authority, as you may know, has authority over the lake and shoreline.

This information and more will soon be coming to you by letter.
